

Basic Rider Course (BRC) Motorcycle Training

In order to enjoy riding to the fullest, first you must learn the physical and mental skills on the road. **Train on our motorcycles, Ninja 300's, Z125's, and Eliminators.**

Passing this course eliminates the need to take the driving test at the DMV. After the completion of this course, rider's receive the "M" endorsement on their driver's license.



Course covers:

- All the basic rules for safe motorcycling.
- Controls, operation and up-keep.
- Safe and legal riding strategies.
- Impairment and distraction.
- Turning, braking, balance and other fundamentals of cycle operation.

The Basic Rider Course (BRC) is Motorcycle Safety Foundation curriculum. All instructors are certified by the State of Nebraska.

Pre-Requisite:

3-Hour E-Course - Printed certificate of completion must be presented at the first meeting of the class on Friday.

The course is 15 hours total, held on Friday evening, Saturday, and Sunday morning.
