Motor vehicle crashes are the leading cause of on-the-job fatalities

74% of road fatalities are NOT buckled

OSHA states you are in violation if you incentivize or condone texting behind the wheel

27% of all crashes involve cell phone use

Medical costs for an injured unbuckled vehicle passenger are triple that of an injured buckled passenger

The Road Safety presentation will include up-to-date information on issues about seat belt safety, distracted driving and cell phone usage. 2019 TRENDS**

248 people died and 17,198 were injured in traffic crashes (2019)

One collision occurs every 14 minutes

47 people were injured every day in motor vehicle crashes

One person was killed every 35 hours due to a vehicle crash

Of the 212 traffic fatalities in 2019, only 80 (38%) were wearing a seat belt. 132 (62%) were not wearing a seatbelt

The Choice Is Yours!

Texting and driving increases your chance of a crash by 23x. Reaching for something increases your chance 9x.
